**7. Monthly Financial Report**

The Secretary will present figures through August 31 for water sales, revenues and expenses in comparison to the 2012 budget, receivables, investments, and the reserve funds for water conservation loans and projects. No Board action is expected.

**8. License Agreement – PG&E Overhead Electrical Line**

PG&E wishes to install an overhead power line across a strip of land owned by CCID north of Meredith Avenue in Gustine, in order to provide service to a new City well in Schmidt Park. A privately-owned pipeline traverses the strip of land, serving several downstream CCID consumers. The proposal meets the applicable District requirements, and the Board will be asked to approve a license agreement, and to authorize the President and Secretary to execute the document on behalf of the District.

**9. Legal and Four-Entities Matters**

General Counsel, the Executive Director and the Manager will discuss with the Board current issues affecting the Exchange Contractors and CCID. Board action may be requested on any of these matters.

**10. Miscellaneous Business**

At this time, Board members and staff may discuss matters that are not on the agenda which may affect operations of the District. No Board action is expected to be taken.
