Subject: Important Water Supply Update

We need your help.

Last Monday we informed you that the United States Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation) discovered that the temperatures in Shasta Lake are warmer than had been tracking earlier when they developed the current temperature and operations plans. The discovery renders those plans untenable.

Over the last week, Reclamation has been working with National Marine Fisheries Service, Fish and Wildlife, and State Board Staff to reformulate the plans. The plans are due out now by this Wednesday.

We need your help at this key time to encourage the State Board and our state and federal representative to ensure that final plans provide for our vital summer water deliveries as promised by the earlier plan, while providing reasonable temperature and physical protections to salmon.
