

**CENTRAL CALIFORNIA IRRIGATION DISTRICT
2017 WATER SUPPLY UPDATE – February 22, 2017**

Due to the extraordinary weather conditions and high flood flows during recent weeks, conditions have been so wet that CCID has about 15,000 acre-feet of water available for use before the end of March. Also, since groundwater levels throughout the District are still in need of recovery from the 2014 and 2015 drought years, our Board of Directors voted this morning to modify our water sales rules for February and March. Starting today, February 22, until the 15,000 acre-feet of water is exhausted, any irrigation water that is used will not count against the tiered pricing level limits that were adopted for 2017, and will be billed at \$15.00 per a.f. for in-District and \$40.00 per a.f. for Class II lands. The District will be monitoring usage closely, and will notify our consumers when this supply of water is about to run out. After that time, all water used will again be counted against the year's tiered pricing limits.
